The "global verantwortlich BW - Lieferketten nachhaltig gestalten" project is a programme coordinated by the Network for Corporate Responsibility and Social Engagement UPJ e.V. on behalf of the Ministry of Economic Affairs, Labor, and Tourism of Baden-Württemberg.

The project's objective is the **promotion of sustainability and** ethical practices within supply chains, particularly for companies in Baden-Württemberg.

The programme is aimed primarily at companies in Baden-Württemberg that are developing and implementing sustainable value and supply chain management in a global **competitive environment**. The offer focuses on a programme of public information events and online seminars as well as indepth workshops and digital meetings within a company network.



















Activities

global verantwortlich BW is a free support programme, focusing on company networking, peer learning and interdisciplinary dialogue at various events:



Public events:

Public events and online seminars highlight the implementation options and challenges of sustainable value and supply chain management and discuss current and future regulatory requirements from the perspective of various stakeholders.



Company network:

Participants of the free company network join representatives of Baden-Württemberg companies in practical work on their own sustainable supply chain management, developing it further in various peer learning formats.

The programme supports enterprises with the following formats:

- Workshops practical input, group work and exchange formats
- Online network meetings knowledge transfer between network participants
- Video consultations participants can exchange with experts
- Mutual support in dyads participants provide each other with confidential, collegial advice
