## About the project

The **Voucher program** (Vouchers for Co-Financing Individual Services for Improving Business Competences) is an initiative coordinated by the Slovene Enterprise Fund.

The main purpose of the voucher program is the establishment of a system of allocating small-scale incentives. This allows micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (MSEs and SMEs) to have significantly simplified access to co-funding for specific services. The aim is to help them strengthen their competitiveness, competencies, market presence and reputation, and innovativeness in areas based on their specific needs such as the circular/green economy, digitalization, internationalization, intellectual property protection, certification, etc.



#### SIMPLE & FAST & ACCESSIBLE PROCESSING

The Voucher Program offers simple and accessible small value incentives for SMEs. They are quick and easy to obtain, being available throughout the whole year and without any excessive approval procedures. SMEs can benefit from a maximum of 3 active vouchers, or a total value of a maximum of 30,000.00 per year.



#### CO-FINANCING 60% OF ELIGIBLE COSTS

The Voucher Program is co-financing up to a max. of 60% of the eligible costs per granted voucher or in the amount of a lump sum.

### Voucher forms

The most notable aspect of the voucher programme is its demand-driven structure, which allows SMEs to apply for support in specific thematic areas relevant to their development needs:

Voucher for participation in business delegations abroad	Life cycle assessment (LCA) voucher	SME Sustainability Reporting Voucher (ESG voucher)
Voucher for obtaining quality certificates	Voucher for the status transformation of companies	Intellectual property protection voucher
Ownership transfer voucher	Cyber security voucher	Voucher to boost prototyping in startups

Vouchers are implemented through public calls in which no evaluation methodology or scoring criteria are used. Beneficiaries are selected based on meeting the conditions specified in the public call. Applications are processed on a "first come, first served" basis.

## Open Vouchers until 31 March 2028

## V1 – Voucher for participation in business delegations abroad

<u>Purpose:</u> Encourage companies to join economic delegations by facilitating connections with potential business partners.

Amount of funding: Minimum subsidy: 300 €

Maximum subsidy: 3.000 €

Available funds: 0.5M €

#### V2 – Voucher for patents, models, brands

<u>Purpose</u>: Protect intellectual property (IP) by covering

costs related to patents, designs, and trademarks.

Amount of funding: Minimum subsidy: 500 €

Maximum subsidy: 5.000 €

Available funds: 2.0M €

#### V3 – Voucher for Certification

<u>Purpose:</u> Supports companies in obtaining, maintaining, or renewing internationally recognized certifications and management systems.

Amount of funding: Minimum subsidy: 1.000,00 €

Maximum subsidy: 9.999,99 €

Available funds: 3.0M €

#### V4 – Voucher for transfer of ownership

<u>Purpose</u>: Support companies in preparing and implementing ownership transitions, ensuring business continuity, job preservation, and enhanced competitiveness.

Amount of funding: Minimum subsidy: 500 €

Maximum subsidy: 3.000 or 9.000 €

Available funds: 0.7M €

## V5 – Voucher for the Status Transformation of Companies

<u>Purpose:</u> Encourage companies to join economic delegations by

facilitating connections with potential business partners.

Amount of funding: Minimum subsidy: 1.000 €

Maximum subsidy: 5.000 €

Available funds: 1.50M €

V6 – Voucher for Co-financing the Development of Project Proposals for Calls for Tenders under the Second Pillar of EU's Horizon Europe Framework Programme

Amount of funding: Minimum subsidy: 500 €

Maximum subsidy: 4.000 €

Available funds: 0.5M €

## VL – Voucher for Research, Development and Design in Woodworking Enterprises 24-2

Application deadline: only until March 2025

<u>Purpose:</u> To increase the competitiveness and growth

of enterprises in the woodworking industry.

Amount of funding: Minimum subsidy: 1000,00 €

Maximum subsidy: EUR 9.999,99 €

Available funds: 0.3M €

## Voucher acquisition procedure

**Public call** 

Easy and quick application preparation

**Electronic submission** 

The company submits the application via ePortal.

**Application processing at Slovene Enterprise Fund** 

The SEF examines the submitted application. The complete applications, which also comply with all of the requirements set out in the call for tenders, will be approved and funded within the limits of the available funds. A co-financing agreement is forwarded to all the applicants who have been successfully selected for funding.

#### Signing agreement with the SEF

If the application is approved, a cofinancing agreement is signed with the SEF. The contract signing and delivery are carried out digitally, by means of a qualified digital certificate for business entities.
