# Priority objectives and specific objectives of DTP II (2021-2027)

### PO1: A smarter Europe

i. developing and enhancing research and innovation capacities and the uptake of advanced technologies

iv. developing skills for smart specialisation, [just transition], industrial transition and entrepreneurship

### PO2: A greener, low-carbon Europe

ii. promoting renewable energy

iv. promoting climate change adaptation, and disaster risk prevention, resilience, taking into account eco-system based approaches

v. promoting access to water and sustainable water management vii. enhancing biodiversity, green infrastructure in the urban environment, and reducing pollution



## POs and SOs of DTP II

# Priority objectives and specific objectives of DTP II (2021-2027)

### PO4: A more social Europe

i. enhancing the effectiveness and inclusiveness of labour markets and access to high quality employment through developing social infrastructure and promoting social economy

ii. improving equal access to inclusive and quality services in education, training and lifelong learning through developing accessible infrastructure

v. enhancing the role of culture and tourism in economic development, social inclusion and social innovation

### ISO1: A better cooperation governance

i. enhance institutional capacity of public authorities and stakeholders to implement macro-regional strategies and sea-basin strategies, as well as other territorial strategies
